



Hand in Hand Child Care Society- Monthly Health Assessment Waiver

2020/2021 School Year

Following the BC Centre for Disease Control's Covid-19 Public Health Guidance all parents, guardians, and/or caregivers have the responsibility to conduct a Daily Health Assessment of their child every day before sending them into a child care setting.

Parents/ guardians will be required to self-assess their child for key symptoms of illness daily, before sending them to Hand in Hand. These symptoms include: Fever (Body temperature of <37.5), chills, cough, or worsening of chronic cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell or taste, diarrhea, and nausea/ vomiting. As a reminder, if your child is experiencing any of the above symptom(s) they should stay home for 24 hours from when the symptom(s) started. If the symptom(s) persist or worsen, seek a health assessment by calling 8-1-1.

Completion of this waiver confirms that as the primary caregiver, you will conduct a daily health assessment of your child BEFORE sending them to Hand in Hand.

Families will need to complete the waiver each month, along with their monthly calendar. If the waiver is not completed the staff will complete the daily health assessment with you until the monthly waiver is submitted.
